To Our Residents, Family Members and Staff

Your peace of mind is important to us and we appreciate all the well wishes we have received during this difficult time. The individuals who live under our roof are loved by you and all of us.

Antigen testing began Monday, November 30, 2020. The antigen test requires a bilateral nasal swab. Once the specimen is collected, it takes only 15 minutes to get the test result. All staff has been tested and will be tested every other day for two weeks or until the antigen testing supplies run out. (Unfortunately, testing supplies are limited. Abrams Residence will be notified by the Department of Health if and when more testing supplies are available.

Another round of testing was completed and there are no positive results amongst staff or residents. This is wonderful news of course. All the residents that tested positive in the past are recovered and feeling healthy. In addition, one of the two staff that tested positive has fully recovered and is doing well. The other staff member is still at home, but she is also doing well. Abrams Residence will continue to test residents and staff on a regular basis.

Important news: Abrams Residence and CVS will be holding a vaccination clinic on January 16, from 1-7 for staff and residents. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to call.

Abrams Residence continues best practices in prevention through mandatory screening of staff and residents; immediate proactive testing for persons with any symptoms; mandatory use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and many other measures.

On an ongoing basis, management at the Abrams Residence is closely monitoring the COVID-19 surge in our county and the state. Unfortunately, as you may be aware, the positive cases are soaring in NJ and the Governor has implemented new restrictions due to the pandemic. Our first priority at Abrams is everyone's safety and we are constantly educating ourselves in the best approach to achieve that. In regards to visitations, it is very dependent on certain variables.
