Resident / family visitation COVID – 19 Outbreak

Starting 6/21/20

Revised 8/15/20

Visitation Protocol

1. Family / resident must sign a consent form acknowledging the risk of having a face/ face visit.
2. The visitor will notify the facility at least 4 hours in advance that they are planning a visit.
3. Prior to the visit, the temperature of the resident and visitor(s) will be taken. If either party has a fever, the visitation will be canceled. In addition, there will be the standard questionnaire (screening). If either party is a risk there will be no visit.
4. If staff / resident have tested positive within the last 14 days or have had symptoms within the last 14 days the “visitation” will not be permitted.
5. A staff member must be present at all times during the visit.
6. The staff, resident, and visitor need to wear a mask that covers their nose and their mouth. Cloth masks are not allowed. The mask cannot be removed at any time during the visitation.
7. The visit is outdoors only in the designated area. The resident and visitor(s) will have designated areas to sit which are more than six feet away. NO exceptions!!
8. Under no circumstance will visitor(s) be allowed in the building. They are not allowed to use the restrooms, make a phone call or go into the resident’s room!!!
9. There is a maximum of only two visitors at one time. The limit of time is 15 minutes.
