ABRAMS RESIDENCE VISITATION GUIDELINES AS OF JULY 1, 2021

INDOOR visiting (fully vaccinated residents)

- Contact 2 days prior to schedule your visit

- Visitors may be offered a rapid Covid test once per week.
- Visitors will have their **temperature taken and sign in** at the front desk.
- Visitors will be asked if they have signs/symptoms of Covid-19 at check-in and sign a consent form.
- Front desk will make a copy of your Covid-19 vaccination card (at first visit only)
- Visit duration is 30 minutes, unless a longer duration is arranged in advance.
- Visitors **must wear a KN95 or surgical mask** (available at front desk if needed) at all times when travelling through the building to a resident room or visiting area.
- Visitors will be escorted to the resident room or visiting area, and will not enter resident common areas (i.e. day room, dining room) or loiter at the nurses' station.
- Two visitors per resident at a time; only visitors age 18+ are permitted indoors.

Residents in a SHARED ROOM:

- **Visitation in the resident's room is discouraged** when the roommate is present, in order to be respectful of the safety and comfort of the roommate.
 - Staff will <u>NOT</u> remove a roommate from the room to accommodate a visit; it is each resident's right to remain comfortably in their room if desired.
- Alternative visiting areas will be arranged when scheduling (i.e. outside, visiting area).
 Masks must be worn in indoor visiting areas.

Residents in **PRIVATE ROOM**:

- Visitation in the resident's room is permissible.
- Masks may be removed inside of the room only during your visit, if all parties are vaccinated.

OUTDOOR visiting (fully vaccinated residents)

- These visits <u>are available only if weather permits.</u> Excess temperature/heat index and/or rain will move visits indoors or cause postponement.
- Visit duration is 30 minutes, unless a longer duration is arranged in advance.
- Residents and visitors may remove masks outdoors
- You may share food and beverages on the patios during outdoor visits.
- Outdoor visits cannot occur on the patio while groups of residents are present for outdoor activities. The Activities staff will block off certain hours each day for resident outdoor and activity time, which may affect availability of your first-choice visit time.

General Reminders

- * For visitation necessary outside of the stated time slots, please contact the wellness nurses at extensions 385 or 387 or myself, David Katz, to discuss how we can best accommodate any time constraints.
- * PLEASE NOTE for <u>unvaccinated</u> residents or visitors, <u>masks must be worn during indoor</u> and outdoor visits and social distance between visitor and resident must be maintained
